Starters

What's one habit that you've gotten rid of? Or one that you'd like to get rid of? How did you go about causing that habit to die?

Digging Deeper

1. Read Romans 6:1-10. The phrase, "We died to sin," is very important. What does it mean? How do you die to sin? (Col 3:3-5; 1 Peter 2:24).
2. What is Jesus' role in enabling us to die to sin? How did He show us? (Col 3:9-10).
3. What does it mean to be united with Jesus (Rom 6:5) and how does being united with Jesus affect our status with sin?
4. Read Romans 6:10-14. In verse 11, the verb "count yourselves" means "to reckon." What do you think this phrase means? What are you to do?
5. How does this reckoning relate to having a new identity and being part of a new (God's) family? What is your emotional response to Jesus being reckoned a sinner so that you could be reckoned as dead to sin and alive to God? (Rom 7:5, 12:1).

Group Challenge

Encourage each other to live by the Spirit and ask the Holy Spirit to produce in us the fruit of the Spirit, which is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control (Gal 5:22-25). More Holy Spirit and less me.
