Do you have a special Easter memory? Pastor Will shared how the Israelites and Jesus celebrated Passover. Most Christians believe Passover is a Jewish holiday. But should Christians observe Passover?

Digging Deeper

- 1. What does Passover commemorate? (Exodus 12:7-14)
- 2. Did Jesus celebrate Passover? (Luke 2:41, 22:14-16; Matt 26:17-19; Mark 14:13-17)
- 3. Is there a connection between Jesus and the Passover? What were the Israelites in bondage to? (Exodus 1:14) What are all human beings in bondage or slavery to? (Rom 6:16-18; 2 Peter 2:19)
- 4. Why did the angel of death spare the Israelites' first born? (Exodus 12:21-23) How are Christians freed from the death of sin today? (John 1:29; Eph 1:7, 2:13; Hebrews 9:14; 1 Peter 1:18-19)
- 5. Read 1 Corinthians 5:6-8. Keep in mind that yeast represents sin. What does this Scripture mean to you? (Gal 5:7-9; Deut 16:3)


