GROUP NOTES

1. How does the concept of having “no room” for Jesus, as discussed in Luke 2:4-7, resonate with our lives today? In what ways do we observe ignorance, indifference, and lack of involvement when it comes to acknowledging Jesus in the modern world?
2. Reflecting on Psalms 2:2-3, how do we see the world displaying a figurative “no room” for Jesus? Can you share examples from contemporary culture, society, or individual lives that illustrate this resistance or rejection?
3. In Matthew 11:28-30, Jesus invites us to come to Him and find rest. How can we practically “make room” for Jesus in our celebrations, within our church communities, in our personal devotions, and through sacrificial giving? What changes or intentional actions can we implement to ensure Jesus has a prominent place in these aspects of our lives?
4. Discuss the challenges and distractions that often lead to making “no room” for Jesus in our lives during the Christmas season. How can we overcome these obstacles and ensure that Jesus is at the center of our celebrations and activities?
5. Considering the theme of making room for Jesus, share personal experiences or testimonies of times when intentionally creating space for Jesus transformed your celebrations, church life, devotional practices, or sacrificial giving.
6. How can we, as a group, encourage and support each other in making room for Jesus during the Christmas season and beyond? Are there specific accountability measures or shared practices we can implement to keep Christ at the forefront of our lives?
