1. Reflecting on John 16:7, what does it mean to carry heaven on earth? How does the Holy Spirit empower us to manifest heavenly realities in our daily lives?
2. In John 14:12, Jesus declares that believers will do even greater works than He did. Discuss the significance of this promise and how it relates to the concept of carrying heaven on earth.
3. 2 Corinthians 4:7 describes believers as vessels carrying the treasure of God's glory. How does this imagery shape our understanding of our identity and purpose as Christians?
4. Explore Revelations 3:14-20, particularly Jesus' invitation to the Laodicean church to open the door for Him to come in. How does this passage relate to the idea of carrying heaven on earth?
5. In Song of Solomon 5:2-8, the beloved seeks the bridegroom but is unable to find him. How does this allegory speak to the longing for intimacy with Christ and the pursuit of carrying heaven on earth?
6. Reflect on the story of the disciples on the road to Emmaus in Luke 24:13-35. How does Jesus reveal Himself to them, and what lessons can we learn about recognizing His presence in our lives today?
7. Discuss practical ways we can experience and manifest the presence of God in our daily lives, drawing from the teachings and examples found in these passages.
8. Consider the obstacles and challenges we may face in carrying heaven on earth. How can we overcome these barriers and live out our heavenly citizenship amidst the realities of this world?
9. Reflect on personal experiences of encountering God's presence and witnessing His power at work in and through you. How have these moments shaped your understanding of carrying heaven on earth?
10. Discuss how our understanding of carrying heaven on earth impacts our interactions with others, our approach to challenges, and our engagement with the world around us.
